	3. Maintain good hygiene practices- sterilizing hands, washing hands, coughing, or sneezing into your elbow, cleaning surfaces	
	6. If drinks are provided everyone must be seated to be served.	
	7. No intermingling between defined spaces. eg when entering, leaving, or going to the bathroom.	
	If you symptoms or feel unwell, stay at home, and seek medical advice, have a test.
