Psychic Bids Policy (Pysch, Pysche)	
Policy	<p>Definition</p> <p>Psychic bids are defined in the NZ Bridge Manual, section D.37</p> <p>Psychic bids are only permitted in A grade club competitions</p> <p>Persistent "psyching" is not permitted. Directors shall regard more than two deliberate gross mis-descriptions by a partnership in any one session as evidence of persistent psyching.</p> <p>Members who believe:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an illegal psychic bid has been made should address this with the session Director at the first opportunity • a player or partnership has made frequent use of psychic bids should address this with the club Recorder <p>Note</p> <p>Members who make or are considering making psychic bids must familiarise themselves with NZBA regulations relating to these, as specific types are forbidden by these rules</p>
