	 an illegal pyschic bid has been made should address this with the session Directer at the first opportunity
	• a player or partnership has made frequent use of pyschic bids should address this with the club Recorder

	Members who who make or are considering making psychic bids must familiarise themselves with NZBA regulations relating to these, as specific types are forbidden by these rules
